Restoration House - Our name summarizes our mission: to help restore broken lives by offering Christian faith-based transitional residential living. We provide a support structure for men who are on parole or probation who are committed to life and lifestyle change. Acceptance priority is given to men returning to Sacramento and neighboring counties.

Restoration House provides a sober community living environment in a beautiful and peaceful residence in the Fruitridge East area of Sacramento. Personal responsibility, respect for others, conflict resolution, communication, and similar skills are learned and lived. Residents agree to curfews, random drug tests, and to supporting one another. We accept applications without regard to ethnicity, age, race, or sexual orientation. We are not able to accept PC 290 registrants, anyone on home detention/ankle monitor, or anyone unable to easily navigate stairs.

We are certified by and a member of CCAPP (California Consortium of Addiction Programs and Professionals). We have a certified substance abuse counselor on staff. We are not a licensed treatment facility, and we do not provide detox, medical or psychological services. We are not a Westcare/STOP program.

Restoration House addresses the whole person. Components of our support structure include:

Spiritual - Bible study, prayer and life-sharing time are the core of our program. Each resident is expected to worship and become involved in a church of his choice.

Educational - Residents are encouraged to participate in ongoing education: school, GED preparation, or vocational training.

Life-Skills Training - We offer opportunities to learn money management and budgeting; cooking; social and relational skills; finding and using community resources for employment and other needs.

Rehabilitation - Each resident sets personal goals and has a personalized program within the overall community-life program. Progress and accountability are monitored by individual meetings with staff, and in resident group meetings. Residents are encouraged to participate in AA, NA, or other self-help groups.

Employment - Residents are required to seek and hold full time employment. If disabled, applicants must be currently receiving Social Security Disability benefits, or have personal or family support to pay fees.

Fees - \$450/month includes shared double room and bath, bedding and linens, laundry, basic personal hygiene items, cable TV, computer Internet access and e-mail, weight room, and program services. Food is \$150.00 per month or food stamps. General assistance funds may be applied to fees. Financial adjustments are made for new residents while they seek employment.

Note: If an applicant is accepted tentatively, a \$50.00 deposit will be required prior to an official acceptance letter. (If another person will provide the deposit, provide contact information.)
