

RESTORATION HOUSE --- Reentry Residential Program for Men

Restoration House – Our name is our mission: to help restore broken lives by offering a Christian faith-based transitional residential community. We provide a support structure for men who are on parole or probation who are committed to life and lifestyle change. Acceptance priority is given to men returning to Sacramento and neighboring counties.

Restoration House provides a sober living environment in a beautiful and peaceful residence in the Fruitridge East area of Sacramento. Personal responsibility, respect for others, communication, conflict resolution, and similar skills are learned and lived. Residents agree to curfews, random drug tests, and to supporting one another. We accept applications without regard to ethnicity, race, age, or sexual orientation. We are not able to accept PC 290 registrants, Alternative Custody (ACP) applicants, or anyone unable to easily navigate stairs.

We are certified by and a member of California Consortium of Addiction Programs and Professionals (CCAPP). We have a certified substance abuse counselor on staff. We are not a licensed treatment facility, and we do not provide detox, medical, or psychological services.

Restoration House addresses the whole person. Components of our support structure include:

Spiritual – Bible study, prayer, and life-sharing time are the core of our program. Each resident is encouraged to worship in a Christian church of his choice.

Educational – Residents are encouraged to participate in ongoing education: GED, college, or vocational training.

Life-Goals Training – Each resident sets personal goals and has a personalized program within the overall community-life program. We offer opportunities to learn money management and budgeting; basic meal preparation; social and relational skills; finding and using community resources for employment and other needs. Accountability and progress are monitored by weekly individual meetings with staff, and in resident group meetings. Residents are encouraged to participate in AA, NA, or other self-help groups.

Employment – Residents are normally expected to seek and hold employment, or to have personal or family support to pay fees, or to have Social Security or Social Security Disability benefits eligibility already approved.

Fees: We are an approved BPH and Parole/Probation reentry program, but we are not a Westcare/STOP contracted program. Residents may qualify for CDCR fees assistance once at Restoration House, but this is not guaranteed. For residents not eligible for CDCR assistance, a subsidized \$650/month fee is available.

Fees Include: shared double room with bath;, bedding and linens; meals and 24-hour kitchen access; basic personal hygiene items, cable TV, computer Internet access, Wi-Fi, weight room, and program services.

Note: If an applicant is accepted tentatively, a \$50.00 deposit will be required prior to an official acceptance letter. Do not send the deposit before it is requested.
